– Genesis of JV

Indian-Russian joint venture BrahMos was established in India through an Inter-Governmental Agreement between the two countries signed in February 1998. The acronym BrahMos is perceived as the confluence of two great nations represented by two great rivers, the Brahmaputra of India and the Moskva of Russia. Defence Research & Development Organisation (DRDO) from India and the Federal State Unitary Enterprise NPO Mashinostroyenia (NPOM) from Russia are the joint venture partners of the Company. The Company is instituted with an authorized capital of \$250 million with 50.5% from Indian side and 49.5% from Russian side respectively. The JV Company is responsible for joint design, development, production and marketing of Supersonic Cruise Missile Systems with the participation of multiple Indian and Russian institutions and industries. The BRAHMOS system will be inducted in Indian and Russian Armed Forces and also will be exported to friendly countries. Joint Venture BrahMos is an exemplary example of seamless integration and rapid development of high technology defence products to the world market.
